Measuring 28 inches by 27.5 inches, it is also available in Brazilian café, vert de gris, brown and ebony finishes.

### FRENCH CONNECTION

This season, you can have yourself a very Jean de Merry (JDM) Christmas with home goods from its newest designer-exclusive collection, **HF/1.0**. The brainchild of Sydney-based duo Hamel + Farrell, the collection incorporates highly sculptural forms and exotic materials (think zebrawood) in 10 spotlight-stealing pieces. A true couture collection in keeping with JDM's penchant for deco-inspired works, HF/1.0 pays contemporary homage to big names such as Leleu, Niemeyer and Parzinger. Hand-carved wood and hammered patterns add rich textures, while bronze and lacquered finishes provide sleek detailing. The craftsmanship is what you'd expect from one of the design world's reigning stars, and like all Jean de Merry creations, these are gifts to last. Case in point: The Lumiere chandelier that Kelly Wearstler installed in Bergdorf Goodman's New York resto, which has since become one of the most Pinterest pinned trimmings around—merry and bright!
